

Example of how to fill out the Woman of the Year Nomination form.

A. **YEARS OF CLUB MEMBERSHIP** (minimum of 5 years)

15 year member of XYZ Homemaker Club

B. **CLUB ACTIVITIES** (30 points) offices held, committees served

1. Offices held – President, Vice-President, Health & Nutrition Chairman, Secretary, Family Coordinator
2. Committees served on – Fair booth, Community cleanup, Window display at library, Banner design for club, Quilt for St. Jude, workshops

C. **COUNTY ACTIVITIES** (30 points) committees served on, committee chairmanships held, county offices held, participation in county events, etc.

1. President, Parliamentarian, Family Coordinator, Environmental Coordinator
2. Cookbook committee, Day In May committee, Literacy & Essay contests
3. Attends Day in May, Holiday Bonanza, District Meetings, painting class workshop, cooking with mixes workshop

D. **STATE ACTIVITIES** (30 points) office held, committees served on, participation in state meetings

1. District program coordinator, treasurer
2. Committee to decorate tables at banquet, check-in cultural arts
3. Taught a workshop, participate in fashion show, participate in talent show

E. **COMMUNITY & CHURCH ACTIVITIES** (20 points)

1. Panoply volunteer, Girl Scout Leader, President of PTA, room mother
2. Sunday School Teacher, VBS teacher, work with youth in GA's, Mission Friends
